WELCOME TO SUMMER 2012!

We make summer fun every day at Westfield Area Y camps. The Y is a safe, thriving environment for campers to try new activities, learn new skills, be creative, make lasting friendships, and have a blast!

Our camp program features an array of traditional, sports, specialty, travel, and teen camps. Join us for one or more weeks or all summer long. Full-day, half-day and extended day programs are available for campers ages 3-15. We offer programs in Garwood, Mountainside and Westfield. Our Westfield-based programs are ACA accredited.

The Y camp curriculum is structured to promote teamwork, build self-esteem and include educational components. We incorporate the Y core values of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility in all we do.

Every member of our camp staff receives over 30 hours of pre-camp training including Red Cross certification in CPR for the Professional Rescuer and First Aid with EpiPen administration as well as asthma inhaler training, anti-bullying, behavior management and more. We also have a full-time EMT on staff during the camp season.

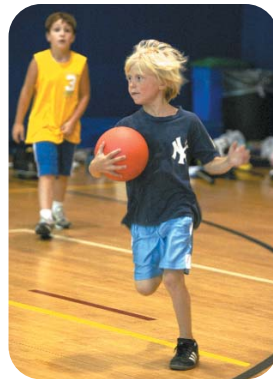

REGISTRATION

REGISTRATION DEADLINES

Many camps fill quickly. We recommend you register early to secure your first choices. If a camp is full, a waiting list will be started. Registration for camps and before/after care is required by the Wednesday prior to the camp session. Registration or changes after close-of-business Wednesday require payment of a \$25 administrative fee.

DEPOSITS/PAYMENTS

CHANGES/CANCELATIONS

Changes and cancelations must be in writing and delivered in person to the Welcome Center. Camp deposits and membership fees are non-transferable and non-refundable. Changes require payment of a \$25 administrative fee, per change, per child. Should you need to cancel your child's registration, credits are issued, less deposit and \$10 processing fee, as follows:

- 30 days before session start: 100% credit
- 21-29 days before session start: 50% credit

No credits will be offered if received 20 days or fewer prior to the start of the session.

MEMBERSHIP

Most camps are for Westfield Area Y members only. Membership must be current or obtained at the time of registration and remain current for the duration of camp. Camps offer a reduced full member fee (for Family and Teen members) and a Program member fee (for Program and Pre-Teen Plus members). Note—for camp participation only—pre-teens and teens may obtain a Program membership.

Immunization dates are required. A physical is NOT required. A physician's signature is NOT required. Summer 2011 campers may update and approve the information previously provided. If your child requires medication or needs to carry an EpiPen at camp, note it on the above form. In addition, a "Medication Distribution Form" signed by a physician needs to be returned to the Y prior to the start of camp. This form is available online or at the Welcome Center.
